

Agreement for Painting or Installation of Private Attachments on Essential Energy Equipment

Unless otherwise specified, defined terms in CEOP8037 Essential Energy Equipment: Painting or Installation of Private Attachments have the same meaning in this Agreement.

In consideration for Essential Energy granting _____ (the **Applicant**) permission to Paint or install Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners on Essential Energy equipment as described in the Applicant's letter of _____ (a copy of which is attached to this Agreement), the Applicant:

- 1 Agrees to ensure that its employees, agents and subcontractors (including ASPs):
 - a Comply with Essential Energy Equipment: Painting or Installation of Private Attachments (CEOP8037) as may be revised or replaced by Essential Energy from time to time; and
 - b Obey all reasonable directions provided by Essential Energy in whatever form, including Essential Energy policies and guidelines, in relation to any Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners installed by the Applicant on Essential Energy equipment.
- 2 Accepts all liability arising from any Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners installed by the Applicant on Essential Energy equipment and indemnifies Essential Energy against all losses, liabilities and costs incurred by Essential Energy in connection with any damage or injury arising out of such Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners.
- 3 Must remove any Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners installed by the Applicant from Essential Energy equipment as directed by Essential Energy and make good any damage caused by such removal and, if the Applicant fails to comply with Essential Energy's direction, Essential Energy may:
 - a Remove the Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners and dispose of them
 - b Make good any damage caused by such removal; and
 - c Recover the cost of doing so as a debt due and payable on demand.
- 4 Agrees that in an emergency, Essential Energy may without notice remove any Paintings, Private Attachments, or Promotional Signs or Banners installed by the Applicant from Essential Energy equipment without incurring any liability to the Applicant; and
