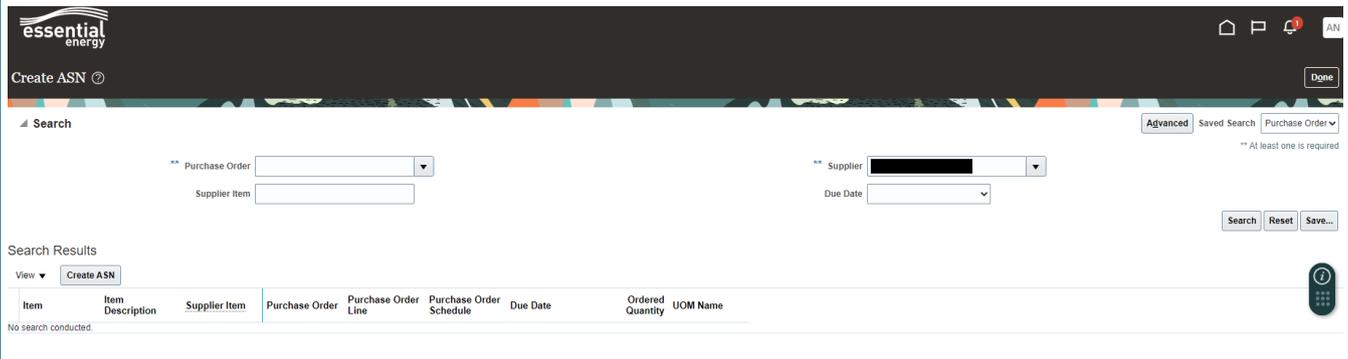

 <p>Who might use this guide?</p>	<p>This guide provides information to assist you in creating an Advanced Shipment Notice (ASN) which contains details of the shipment such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order information • Delivery date and time • Location information • Product details • Information about the carrier <p>Note: some fields are Mandatory and are indicated by *</p>

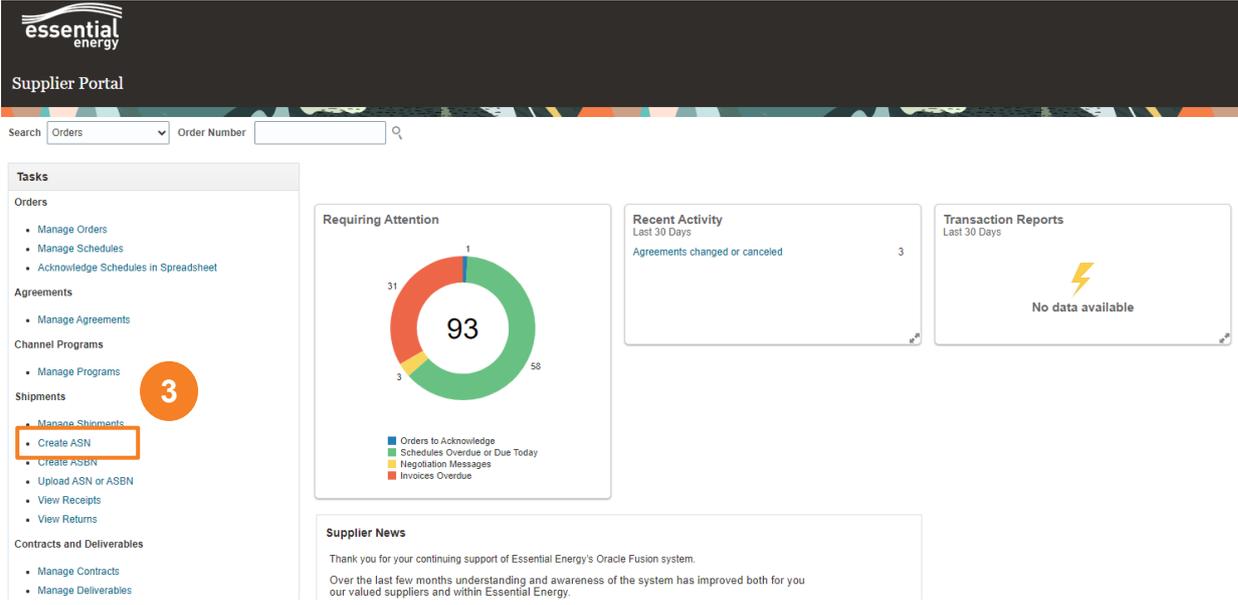
Overview

What is an Advanced Shipping Notice?

An **Advanced Shipping Notice (ASN)** is an electronic notification of an upcoming delivery which is sent directly from a supplier to a buyer, in advance of the shipment.

What does the Create ASN homepage look like?



Step	Action
<p>1</p> <p>2</p>	<p>Login to the system.</p> <p>Navigate to the Supplier Portal tab.</p> <p>Click on the Supplier Portal app.</p> 
<p>3</p>	<p>From the Supplier Portal homepage, scroll down the Task list and select Create ASN.</p>

4	<p>There are two options to search for purchase orders in the Create ASN area and both commence after step 3 (above)</p> <p>Option 1</p> <p>Enter a Purchase Order number into the Purchase Order (PO) field and click on Search.</p>

6	<p>The Search option will show all lines of the PO. Highlight the lines required by clicking on the first row and holding CTRL on your keyboard to choose other lines.</p>

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8	<p>On Create ASN Details page, update the Header area where relevant noting the mandatory fields marked *. 10	<p>Click on Ok.</p> <p>At this point Essential Energy will receive your ASN. If you require further support, please contact suppliers@essnetialenergy.com.au</p>
4 5 6	<p>Option 2 – commences from Step 3 (above)</p> <p>The supplier name will automatically appear in the Supplier field. Without entering any other information, click on Search to view <u>all</u> Open Purchase Orders</p> <p>Note the lines highlighted showing different purchase order numbers.</p> <p>Scroll down the list until the required PO and/or lines are found. Highlight the first required line and hold CTRL on your keyboard to choose other lines.</p>
7	<p>Click on Create ASN.</p>

8	<p>On Create ASN Details page, update the Header area where relevant noting the mandatory fields marked *.
