ASP- Electrical Safety Rules Initial Course



Essential Energy training team is pleased to offer Initial Safety Rules training, aligned to National Units of Competency, across its footprint to eligible Electrical Supply Industry (ESI) workers.

Why is this course needed?

The initial training in the Essential Energy Safety Rules is a Mandatory requirement for Essential Energy Authorisation:

This training supports the need for national mobility of the ESI workforce and provides a standardised approach for workers to gain and maintain approval to work on or near electrical supply industry networks.

This course is a pre-requisite before participants can apply to Authorisations before being granted approval to enroll in the ASP Induction course.

Course Duration

½ day

What will the course do for you or your employees?

Following successful completion of this course the participant will be issued a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment (SoA). This will be issued via post.

Eligibility to attend this course

Participants undertaking this course must have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) number. The USI is a reference number allowing students to access all their training results from all Vocational Education Training (VET) providers. The USI is available online and at no cost to the student and stays with that student for life. If you have not yet obtained a USI you can apply for it directly at <http://www.usi.gov.au/create-your-USI/>.

Essential Energy ASP Level 1 and / or 2- Authorisation Induction



Essential Energy requires that all Electrical Supply Industry (ESI) workers that are Accredited Service Providers undergo an induction before being granted authorisation to work on the network.

Why is this induction needed, and what will the induction do for you or your employees?

Authorisation Induction is required for ASP Level 1 and/or 2 applicants that have either never completed an induction or have not worked on the Essential Energy network as an authorised ASP for a period greater than 12 months.

Following successful completion of this induction, the participant will be issued an authorisations ID card and the authorised person will be granted access to the Essential Energy network.

3 hours

Confirmation

Confirmation will be sent via email upon enrolment.

Eligibility to attend this induction

Participants undertaking this course must have the following in place before applying for authorisation:

- Accreditation as an ASP with the Department of Planning and Environment – including an employee registration letter nominating the classes of authorisation you are able to work in.
- Current Annual Regulatory Training including the units that are relevant to classes of authorisation being sought
- A copy of your qualifications relating to class of authorisation being sought (eg. trade certificate)

Fees

A fee is applicable upon becoming authorised (including induction session cost). This will be outlined at the time of application.

Payment

The authorisation fee and security deposit for sealing pliers, if requested, will be billed to the ASP's sundry debtor account. If you do not have one, this can be created at the time of application.
