<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The supply authority will contact the applicant to advise of a date/time to meet at the nominated site to provide relevant safety advice. ➤ Where work will encroach in the unsafe distance of the overhead power lines, the Principal Contractor and/or his representative must ensure that the appropriate exclusion zones are maintained until written safety advice is received from the relevant supply authority. ➤ The written safety advice shall be issued to the nominated responsible person by a representative of the relevant supply authority. ➤ Charges may apply for the installation of aerial markers, de-energisation or relocation of overhead power lines or the provision of an approved Safety Observer (if required) to carry out the work near overhead power lines. 			
I have obtained a copy of the NSW Code of practice 2006 "Work near overhead power lines" and the relevant guidance material published by Safe Work Australia and acknowledge that I am required to maintain an exclusion zone around the overhead electric lines until such time as I receive written safety advice from the relevant supply authority.
