

# Be a Safety Star

## POSTER COMPETITION

### Terms and Conditions:

1. The promoter is Essential Energy ABN 37 428 185 226 of PO Box 5730 NSW 2444. Phone 13 23 91.
2. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions.
3. The competition will be known as the "Be a Safety Star Poster Competition".
4. The competition is open to all students from Kindergarten to Year 3 across all primary schools registered to participate in Electricity Safety Week (ESW) 2021 and who receive a prize pack from Essential Energy.
5. There is no cap on the number of entries each registered school can submit – it is unlimited – however students must submit an individual entry for their entry to be eligible. Team or class entries will not be eligible.
6. Entries can be submitted by teachers or school principals on behalf of their students, using one of the following methods:

  - Email a colour scan or photo of the completed poster template and entry form contained within the ESW 2021 resource pack to: [postercomp@essentialenergy.com.au](mailto:postercomp@essentialenergy.com.au)
  - Mail the completed poster template and entry form contained within the ESW 2021 resource pack to: Essential Energy, "Be a Safety Star Poster Comp", PO Box 5730, Port Macquarie NSW 2444**OR** by parents if schools are currently remote learning.
7. Original posters and entry forms received cannot be returned.
8. Entries open 9am Monday 12 July and close 5pm Friday, 5 November 2021.
9. For the entry to be eligible, it must contain the following:
  - Full name of school and town
  - Year group, teacher name, student name and class name
  - Contact email address and phone number for the school
  - A safety poster design which is an original creation by the student. It can be a picture, story, poem etc
10. By entering the competition the entrant/school acknowledges that they give Essential Energy permission to reproduce all or part of the entry form in one/all of the following ways – sharing on Essential Energy's Facebook page, on Essential Energy's website, in Essential Energy media releases, in internal publications, for inclusion in future Electricity Safety Week materials or as part of an Essential Energy safety campaign. Entry into this competition does not guarantee reproduction of the entry in the above-mentioned methods.
11. One major prize winner will be judged from each of these two primary school categories (K-1, 2-3) using a merit selection process with the following judging criteria:
  - The poster design must incorporate an electricity safety message created by the students or one of the five key safety messages from this program
  - Creativity and originality of electricity safety tip and poster design
12. The winner will be selected by a judging panel comprised of three Essential Energy representatives. Judging will take place between Monday 8 November and Friday, 12 November 2021. The judge's decision is final.
13. The winners will be notified w/c Monday, 15 November 2021 by email or telephone where applicable.
14. The names of the winning schools/classes and entries will be published on the Essential Energy website at [essentialenergy.com.au/postercomp](https://essentialenergy.com.au/postercomp) and facebook page w/c Monday, 22 November 2021.
15. There will be two major prize winners (one from each category K-Yr 1 and Yr 2-Yr 3) and the prizes include:
  - A donation of \$1,000 to each winning school's P&C Association, to be put towards a safety related improvement for the school
  - An Xtreme Bots - Woki Coding Robot for the two winning students (one from K-Yr 1 category and one from Yr 2-Yr 3 category) valued at \$59.95 RRPThere will be two runner up entries per category and the prize includes:
  - A Logiblocs - Smart Circuits kit for the four runner up entries (two from K-Yr 1 category and two from Yr 2-Yr 3 category) valued at \$24.95 RRPTotal prize draw value = \$1,219.70
