There are prizes for both winners and runners up as well as a \$1000 donation to each winning school P&C Association. Students can use our 6 key safety messages as inspiration for their safety message and art creations.

**Be a Safety Star Colouring-in Competition:** Students in Kindergaten are asked to use their flair for colour and colour in the design. Students must also highlight how to stay safe around electricity when outdoors. Entries will only be accepted for students in Kindergaten.

**Be a Safety Star Poster Competition:** Students can showcase their artistic flair to design a poster illustrating one of the 6 key safety messages – or a safety message of their own creation. You could even create your own safety character! Students must highlight one or more important electricity safety message. Entries will only be accepted for students in Years 1-4 and must be an original creation.

**Safety Star Superhero Comic Competition:** Using the comic strip template, students are invited to enter our Safety Star Superhero comic strip competition by illustrating their Safety Star Superhero helping people stay safe around electricity. Students must highlight one or more important electricity safety message and design their own safety superhero. Entries will only be accepted for students in Years 5-6 and must be an original creation.

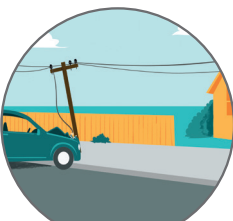
Entries will be judged on creativity and effectiveness of conveying one or more electricity safety message. For entries to be valid for judging, all entries must complete a safety message and must only be completed by the year relevant to that competition.

There is no cap on the number of entries each registered school can submit. Use the back of this form to enter any one of our 3 competitions for 2023 Electricity Safety Week.

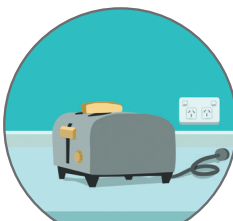
**We have extended the entry period this year, with entries open from Monday, 17 July and closing Friday, 27 October 2023.**
